ORDER

Upon the Defendant's Motion to Modify Conditions of Supervised Release (Doc. 154), and for good cause shown,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendant may practice the religion of the Native American Church and ingest peyote in connection with that practice on the following conditions:

1. The Defendant shall not operate a motor vehicle within 24 hours of ingesting peyote at a ceremony;
2. If the Defendant is attending a ceremony with individuals over 18 years of age, he may do so without a chaperone;
3. If the Defendant is attending a ceremony with individuals under 18 years of age, he shall be accompanied by a chaperone that has been approved by the Defendant's treatment provider;

4. Any individual driving Mr. Medicine Horse to a ceremony must have a valid driver's license.

The Clerk of Court is directed to notify the parties of the making of this Order.
