Legislative History

4A-03.010 Applicability.

An individual must register as a sex offender with the Skagit County Sheriff’s Office if he or she is convicted of a registerable sex offense by a jurisdiction other than the Swinomish Tribal Court and that individual is a resident, employee, or student within the exterior boundaries of the Swinomish Reservation.

4A-03.020 Timing of Registration.

An individual described in STC 4A-03.010 must register with the Skagit County Sheriff’s Office within three business days of establishing residence, commencing employment, or becoming a student within the exterior boundaries of the Swinomish Reservation.

4A-03.030 Registration Requirements.

An individual described in STC 4A-03.010 must register according to the laws of the State of Washington. This includes but is not limited to the laws of the State of Washington that dictate required registration duration, registration information that the registered sex offender must provide, and requirements regarding keeping registration current.

4A-03.040 Address Verification.

(A) If an individual described in STC 4A-03.010 resides within the exterior boundaries of the Swinomish Reservation, the Swinomish Police Department shall make reasonable

attempts to verify that the individual is residing at the registered address. Reasonable attempts require visiting the offender's registered residential address according to the following frequency: for Risk Level I offenders, every twelve months; for Risk Level II offenders, every six months; and for Risk Level III offenders, every three months.

- (B) The Swinomish Police Department shall make reasonable attempts to locate any registered sex offender whose registered residential address is within the exterior boundaries of the Swinomish Reservation and cannot be located at the registered address.

4A-03.050 Duties of Swinomish Police Department.

For an individual described in 4A-03.010, the Swinomish Police Department must input the registration information obtained by the State of Washington into the Swinomish Registry within three business days of receiving the information.
