Resolution No. 51-13-65

Amending the Solid Waste and Recycling Disposal Ordinance

WHEREAS, the Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe with a Constitution enacted pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 U.S.C. Section 476; and


WHEREAS, the Transfer Station Program has revised the Solid Waste and Recycling Disposal Ordinance to better meet the needs of the Bad River Reservation, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and discussed the revisions, and has determined that changes to Section 375.7(b) and creation of Section 375.75 are in the best interests of all persons residing within the Bad River Reservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bad River Tribal Council reviewed and discussed the Solid Waste and Recycling Disposal Ordinance revisions and hereby changes Section 375.7(b) and creates Section 375.75 as presented at this meeting and attached to this Resolution, effective *May 13, 2013*.
