RESOLUTION NO. 8-30-18-1085

Adopting Chapter 500 – Gaming Regulatory Ordinance

- WHEREAS: the Bad River Band of the Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe with a Constitution enacted pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 U.S.C. Section 476; and
- WHEREAS: Article VI, Section 1(m) of the Bad River Constitution authorizes the Bad River Tribal Council to adopt resolutions regulating the procedures of Tribal agencies and Tribal officials, including the proper operation and conduct of the Band's gaming operations; and
- WHEREAS: Federal statutes at 25 U.S.C. Section 2701 et seq., provide that the Tribe's Gaming Operations meet such standards and procedures by adopting gaming regulatory rules to protect tribal assets, the interest of tribal members, and the gaming public; and
- WHEREAS: the Bad River Band's Governing Board updated the Regulatory Ordinance at Chapter 500 to meet the requirements of 25 U.S.C. Section 2701 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bad River Tribal Council hereby adopts Chapter 500 – Gaming Regulatory Ordinance effective August 30, 2018.
