Approving Chapter 324 Water Quality Certification and Water Quality Review Code of the Bad River Band of the Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians

WHEREAS, the Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe with a Constitution enacted pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 U.S.C. Sec. 476, and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency approved the Bad River Band's application for treatment in the same manner as state on June 26, 2009 to administer the Water Quality Standards and Certification programs under Sections 303 and 401 of the Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds the approval of the Chapter 324 *Water Quality Certification and Water Quality Review Code of the Bad River Band of the Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians* attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to be in the best interest of the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby:

1. Approves and adopts the Chapter 324 *Water Quality Certification and Water Quality Review Code of the Bad River Band of the Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians*.
2. Directs the Natural Resources Department to implement the procedures within the Chapter 324 Code when reviewing projects under the Tribe's Water Quality Standards.

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Bad River Band of Lake Superior Tribe of Chippewa Indians, an Indian Tribe organized under Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of seven members, of whom 7 members, constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting hereof duly called, noticed, convened, and held on the 18 day of September, 2018; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 6 members; 0 against; and 0 abstaining, and that the said resolution has not been rescinded or amended.
