RESOLUTION NO. 2022-123

REVISION OF THE LAC COURTE OREILLES BAND OF LAKE SUPERIOR CHIPPWA INDIANS GAMING ENTERPRISES BANISHMENT POLICY PAP.9.13.030

- WHEREAS, the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe ("Tribe") organized pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 U.S.C. §5101, et seq.; and,
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Governing Board serves as the governing body of Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians pursuant to Article III, § 1 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Governing Board pursuant to Article V, Section 1(n) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians shall "regulate, by the enactment of ordinances, the conduct of business within the territory of the band" and Article V, Section 1(h) "to engage in any business that will further the social or economic well-being of members of the Band; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Governing Board duly enacted PAP.9.13.030 and now wishes to amend such section as attached.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Governing Board hereby amends PAP.9.13.030 as attached.
