## RESOLUTION

November 5<sup>th</sup>, 1996

Resolution No. #090-96

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe with a Constitution and By-Laws approved November 18, 1937; and

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council finds that maintenance of its roads and rights of way is of vital and essential importance to the functioning of the community, reservation and government; and


WHEREAS, In the past, there have not been uniform requirements concerning when cars and other obstructions must be removed from the rights of way; and


WHEREAS, Such uniform requirements and rules are needed in order to accomplish the safe and efficient work of the Roads Department and other tribal departments; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council, pursuant to its inherent powers as a sovereign nation, hereby enacts and passes the attached Road Safety Ordinance.

## CERTIFICATION
