WHEREAS, the Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians, is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, exercising its duties and responsibilities as a sovereign nation under a Constitution approved November 18, 1937; and


WHEREAS, the Constitution empowers the Tribal Council, in Article VII, Section 1 (f) to promulgate and enforce ordinances, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, governing the conduct of members of the Community; and

WHEREAS, the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council recognizes that tribal self-governance and self-sufficiency cannot be realized unless control is exercised over such matters as are vital to tribal interests, which includes domestic relations; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Band of Mohican Indians by this resolution enacts Chapter 62 of Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Law, DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE.

CERTIFICATION
