RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community is a federally recognized Indian tribe with inherent sovereign powers and is governed by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council pursuant to the 1937 Constitution, as amended;

WHEREAS, The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has the authority under its Constitution and its inherent rights as a sovereign nation to adopt and amend Ordinances;


WHEREAS, Chapter 21, the Fish and Wildlife Ordinance, was adopted in 1978 and has since been amended, most recently in August 2014; and

WHEREAS, The Fish and Wildlife Board has recommended clarifications to the ordinance in relation to turkey hunting fees for permittees and the trout season for tribal members.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council hereby adopts the following amendments to Chapter 21, which include the following changes: amending subsections 21.9(A)(4), 21.9(B)(3), 21.10(D) and 21.21 (B), (C) and (D).
