Qualifications: Required Qualifications: JD degree from an ABA-accredited school of law and

admission to a state bar. Must have experience and knowledge in federal Indian law, experience with and knowledge of Alaska Native communities and cultures, and experience with federal and/or state court litigation. Minimum seven (7) to ten (10) years of relevant experience as a practicing attorney. Experience in working in coalitions, natural resources law, subsistence law, or voting rights law is a plus. American Indians, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians are encouraged to apply. The successful applicant must be licensed to practice in Alaska or be able to secure

admission to the state bar as soon as reasonably possible.
